Dear Parents and Guardians,

With that being said, it is most crucial that we do our part in seeing that the education children receive at our school continues to be a true gift that we can give to our children and an asset to our community.

The efforts you and your families have put forth to support St. Mary School along with that of the St. Mary parishioners, friends of St. Mary School, teachers and staff have been nothing short of amazing! A couple changes have been put into place this year. We are asking that each family make a \$100 deposit towards their tuition, when the registration form is returned. If the unfortunate happens and St. Mary School is not open next year the deposit will be refunded. This is why it is so important to register as early as possible to give us an accurate student count.

We will also be offering a three year old preschool again. In order to do this, we must have a minimum of eight students registered. The program will be Tuesday and Thursday mornings with a tuition of \$1,000 for the school year.
