- Students will use their Google Account responsibly and for educational use only. This includes following the Acceptable Use Policy regardless of where the device is being used.
- Students are encouraged to create, explore, and collaborate, and learn appropriately!
- Students will only use their school-issued Google account to log onto any device at school (iPad, laptop, lab computer, Chromebook).
- Students will not share or change their passwords.
- Students are NOT permitted to install apps on the school-owned Chromebook or any other device (laptop, iPad, computer). The Technology Coordinator will sync all necessary apps to the devices remotely with no interruption to the student.
- Students must use appropriate language and etiquette in all forms of electronic communication.
- Students are required to follow copyright laws give credit where credit is due.
- Students are not to take or store any photos of themselves or classmates on their Google Drive or on any school-owned device unless explicitly approved by a teacher.
- St. Mary School will monitor student accounts. There should be no expectation of privacy on a school-owned device using a school-managed account.
- We encourage and expect students to ask questions if they are not sure about a choice they make.
