No separate application is required.
	2. Parish Multi-Child Scholarship: \$350 per each additional student To qualify for this scholarship, you must meet the same criteria outlined for the Parish Life Scholarship.
	 3. Parish and/or Diocesan Needs-Based Financial Assistance Application is completed online through FACTS. See the FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment instruction sheet for details. There is a \$30 fee per family to apply. The St. Mary 4ever Committee will cover this cost. Needs-based financial assistance through the Diocese will be awarded to eligible families through July. Apply by March 15, 2021 to be notified in April. Apply by June 1, 2021 to be notified in July. St. Mary School Endowment Fund grant applications will be available mid-March and are due by April 15 to the Parish Office. A separate application must be completed.
	4. EdChoice and EdChoice Expansion Scholarships (State of Ohio) These are state voucher programs that provide qualifying students the opportunity to attend participating private schools. Applications will be available online on February 1 and due April 15 (if not before) to allow St. Mary School time to process your information. Applications are processed in the order they are received. See Ohio Department of Education fact sheet for additional information.
	5. Jon Peterson Scholarships (State of Ohio) The Jon Peterson Special Needs (JPSN) Scholarship Program provides scholarships to students who have an Individualized Education Program (IEP). The scholarship pays for services on the child's IEP. It does not cover tuition.
	_ 6. Parish Welcome Scholarship: \$100 per student Available to each new student in Kindergarten through Grade 8
	7. Bishops' Scholarship for Excellence: \$1,000 Due March 15 for current students in Grades 6 and 7. Requires completion of the application and essay, two recommendations, and completion of FACTS application. St. Mary School may submit up to five applications to the diocese for consideration. Sixteen Bishop Scholarships are awarded in total at the elementary level diocesan wide.
	8. M. Thomas Moore Elementary Scholarship: \$500 Due March 15 for current students in Grades 1 through 7. Based on scholastic achievement in relation to student's potential, school involvement, positive character traits, and completion of FACTS application. St. Mary School may submit four applications to the diocese for consideration. Four M.Thomas Moore Scholarships are awarded in total diocesan-wide.
	_ 9. Payment in Full Discount: \$100 per student This discount is given if full payment is received by 3 p.m., July 1, 2021.
